

Californians want clean, safe, reliable water. For far too long, needed state water infrastructure investments have been delayed, deferred, or tied up in litigation. Therefore, Californians need all elected state and local officials to support the following:



- 1) Environmental regulations regarding water infrastructure, conveyance, capture, and floodwater will be suspended as they were for Los Angeles' So-Fi Stadium and Hetch Hetchy's Improvement Projects.
- 2) All voter approved infrastructure projects will be budgeted and began within the next fiscal cycle. Surface storage, groundwater banking and new water supply sources for people, agriculture, and the environment will be identified.
- 3) Eliminate dumping raw sewage into streams, rivers, lakes, oceans, and tributaries. Sewage is highly toxic to people, plants, and wildlife. While many wastewater agencies are required to put millions of gallons of highly treated wastewater into water bodies for environmental purposes, there are still municipal agencies that are allowed to dump raw sewage and minimally-treated wastewater into streams, rivers, lakes, tributaries, and the ocean.
- 4) Fix the states conveyance system. The system has been ignored for decades and is in desperate need of repairs, replacement, and upgrades.
- 5) The State Water Resources Control Board members shall be elected by California voters, not appointed by the Governor. Public accountability is important.

I confirm to the voters of California that I will act to ensure all the above are addressed. I understand this is critical to Californians, our food supply, and our environment. I hear and understand that the voters who elected me are no longer willing to tolerate the status-quo.
